

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$9,444,184 from the General Fund of the State for the purpose of funding certain State economic and capital development projects and Municipal CIP social and economic projects, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF CHUUK STATE:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$9,444,184, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General  
3 Fund of the State for the purpose of funding certain State  
4 economic and capital development projects and Municipal CIP  
5 social and economic development projects.

6 The sum shall be apportioned as follows:

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1           Section 2. The sum appropriated by Section 1 shall  
 2 be administered by and allotted to the Governor, who shall  
 3 be responsible to the Legislature for ensuring that these  
 4 funds, ~~except Regional Development Projects as set forth in~~  
 5 ~~Item 9 in which sum shall be administered by and is allotted~~  
 6 ~~to the Speaker and President who shall be responsible to the~~  
 7 ~~Legislature for ensuring that such amounts, are used only for~~  
 8 the purposes specified in Section 1, and in accordance with  
 9 the State Financial Management Act, and that no obligations  
 10 are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The sum in  
 11 ~~Item 9 shall be divided equally among the five (5) senatorial~~  
 12 ~~regions, the equal sum of which shall then be divided equally~~  
 13 ~~among the Senators and Representatives from a particular~~  
 14 ~~senatorial region. The Senators and Representatives shall~~  
 15 ~~designate and assign CIP development projects to their~~  
 16 ~~respective senatorial regions and representative districts.~~  
 17 ~~The Senators and the Representatives shall each be~~  
 18 ~~responsible for the management and proper use of the amount~~  
 19 ~~allocated to each of them. All funds herein appropriated~~  
 20 shall remain available until fully expended.

21           Section 3. The Governor, ~~the Speaker and President~~  
 22 shall ~~each~~ submit a report to the Legislature before April  
 23 15, 1991, which shall:

- 24           1) Provide for the full disclosure of the
- 25           obligations incurred against the sum appropriated by
- 26           Section 1, and indicate the status of these funds as
- 27           of April 1, 1991; and
- 28           2) indicate the planned use, during the remainder
- 29           of the fiscal year of funds not obligated as of April
- 30           1, 1991; provided, that a supplemental report covering
- 31           the actual use and obligation of the fund shall be
- 32           submitted to the Legislature or an appropriate
- 33           committee thereof within 20 days after the closing
- 34           of the fiscal year.

Section 4. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
