## AN ACT

To amend Truk State Law No. 1-1-7, to repeal Section 5 thereof, to transfer the responsibilities of the TEAA to the Chuuk Visitors Bureau, to provide for annual report on the use of its fund, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

2	Law No. 1-1-7, is hereby amended to read as follows:
3	"Section 1. Amendment. Title 29 of the Truk
4	District Code is amended by adding Chapter 9 to

14	Section 2. Amendment. Section 4 of Truk State
15	Law No. 1-1-7, is hereby amended to read as follows:
16	"Section 4. Responsible Agency. The Chuuk
17	Visitors Bureau shall be responsible for:
18	1) operating a convenient refund program for
19	the return of metal beverage cans taxed under
20	Section 1 of this Chapter by consumers provided
21	the amount of refund shall not be less than \$.02
22	per can;
23	2) conducting necessary business for the
24	purpose of collection of cans;
25	3) processing and disposal of cans collected;

·.i	4) coordinating collection and
2	disposal of abandoned and junk motor
3	vehicles and machinery;
4	5) performing all other duties
5	incidential to the above."
6	Section 3. Repeal. Section 5 of Truk State Law
7	No. 1-1-7 is hereby repealed, and Sections 6 and 7 are re-
8	numbered as Sections 5 and 6, respectively.
9	Section 4. Amendment. Section 6 of Truk State
10	Law No. 1-1-7 is hereby amended to read as follows:
11	"Section 5. Disposition of Revenue. The
12	State Director of Treasury shall earmark 80% of
13	the taxes collected for the operation of the re-
14	fund program by the Chuuk Visitors Bureau which
15	shall provide an organization of this program
16	and an annual report on the use of the fund. The
17	Chuuk Visitors Bureau shall allocate 70% of its
18	share of the taxes collected for payment to
19	consumers for return of cans under the refund
20	program established by this Act."
21	Section 5. Amendment. Section 7 of Truk State
22	Law No. 1-1-7 is hereby amended to read as follows:
23	"Section 6. Penalty. All taxes which are
24	not paid in accordance with Section 2 of this
25	Act shall be delinquent and subject to a penalty
26	of 20% per month on unpaid taxes. Any payment
27	made on unpaid taxes shall be first applied to
28	the penalty. The determination of delinquency
29	shall be made by the Director of Treasury. Upon
30	notice of a request of hearing by a tax-payer with-
31	in ninety days after determination of
32	delinquency, the Director of Treasury

1	shall conduct a hearing at which time the tax-
2	payers shall present such evidence showing that the
3	delinquency determination is in error or that
4	mitigating circumstances exists; in either case
5	the Director of Treasury shall determine the amount
6	of taxes due, and may determine that no penalty need
7	be paid upon a showing of good cause."
8	Section 6. Effective Date. This Act shall take
9	effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming
10	law without such approval.
