AN ACT

Amending Section 2 and Section 5 of Chuuk State Law No. 193-01, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Amendment. Section 2 of CSL No. 193-01 is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 2. Operating Expenses of the Legislative  
4 Branch. The sum of \$3,011,700.00, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
6 General Fund of the State for the Fiscal Year ending  
7 September 30, 1993 for the purpose of funding the  
8 operation of the Legislative Branch of the State  
9 government. The office expense allowances and the  
10 representation funds for legislators shall be for the  
11 members of the First Legislature. The representation  
12 funds shall be allocated in that Senators shall be  
13 entitled to \$18,000.00 each and Representatives shall  
14 be entitled to \$16,000.00 each. The President and the  
15 Speaker shall be the allottees of these funds. The  
16 funds shall be apportioned as follows:


1 Section 2. Amendment. Section 5 of CSL No.  
 2 193-01 is amended to read as follows:


3 "Section 5. Operating Expenses of Other Programs.  
 4 The sum of \$4,134,573.00, or so much thereof as may be  
 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
 6 of the State for the Fiscal Year ending September 30,  
 7 1993 for the purpose of funding the operations of other  
 8 State Programs. The Governor shall be the allottee of  
 9 these funds, except for Item Q, of which the Election  
 10 Commissioner shall be the allottee.


