## AN ACT

To amend Section 2 of CSL No. 191-16 in order to provide for convening day of a regular session of the Chuuk State Legislature, to add a new section providing for length of recess during regular and special sessions, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

I Section 1 Amendment. Section 2 of CSL No.

2 191-16, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Convening Date. Both Houses of 3 the Chuuk State Legislature shall convene annually in a 4 5 regular session.at 10:00 a.m., on the first Monday in April, PROVIDED that in a general election year, both 6 Houses of the new Legislature shall convene regular session at 12:00 noon on the sixth Tuesday 8 after the general election. Each regular session shall be for not more than 60 working days."

Section 2. New Section. A new section is hereby 11

added to read as follows: 12

"Section 3. Duration of Recess. The Senate 13 House of Representatives shall not go into recess 14 beyond 2 consecutive days more than the other House, 15 PROVIDED that 16 when the Senate and House of Representatives concur with each other by joint 17 resolution, both Houses may go into a recess or several 18 19 recesses the aggregate total of which shall not exceed 20 60 working days during a regular session or 10 working 21 days during a special session. The Senate or the House
