ACT NO. 2-32

AN ACT

Amending the Chuuk State Criminal Code, CSL No. 6-66, by adding a new Section 308 to chapter 3 thereof prohibiting the consumption, possession, sale, or distribution of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, including but not limited to snuff, cigarettes and/or controlled substances by persons under the age of 18, prohibition of the sale or distribution to, and the causing to be consumed by, a minor, by an adult, and prohibiting certain advertising of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, including but not limited to snuff, cigarettes and/or controlled substances. and/or controlled substances, providing for inspections, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

- 1 Section 1. Amendment. Chapter 3 of Chuuk State Law No.
- 6-66 is hereby amended by adding a new Section 308 thereto 2
- 3 which reads as follows:
- 4 "Section 308. Responsibility for the Consumption,
- Possession, Sale, or Distribution of Alcoholic Beverages, 5
- Tobacco, Cigarettes, including but not limited to Snuff, 6
- 7 and/or Controlled Substances.
- 8 a) The production, possession, sale, distribution 9 or consumption of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, including but 10 limited snuff, cigarettes, and/or "controlled to substances" as defined under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the FSM 11 Code, as now enacted or as hereinafter amended, by a person 12 under the age of 18 for any purpose other than a medically 13 authorized and/or religious purpose, shall be grounds for 14
- 16 Section 307 above."

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b) Any person 18 years or older, including but not 17

delinquency proceedings against such a person pursuant to

- limited to manufacturers, retailers and distributors, who 18
- 19 purposely distributes, or causes to be distributed to or
- consumed by a person under 18 years of age any amount of 20
- alcoholic beverages, tobacco, including but not limited to 21
- snuff, cigarettes and/or controlled substances as defined in 22
- subsection (a) above, except for medical or religious 23

purposes, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be imprisoned for not less than 30 days or be fined not less than \$100, or both. This subsection shall not be construed to reduce the penalty applicable under any other provision of law.

- c) No manufacturer, retailer or distributor of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, including but not limited to snuff, cigarettes and/or controlled substances, as defined in subsection (a) above, or other person, shall advertise or promote, by billboard, radio, television, public broadcast, handout, device or otherwise for commercial pumposes, other than by radio or cable television where the operator does not control the content of the programming:
 - (1) any tobacco product, including but not limited
 to snuff;
 - (2) any alcoholic beverage, including but not limited to beer, wine, and liquor;
 - (3) any controlled substances, as defined in subsection (a) above.
- Any person who violates the provisions of this subsection (c) shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than \$100 per offense, or imprisoned not less than 30 days per offense, or both.
- d) Notwithstanding the prohibitions of subsection (c) of this section, nothing herein shall prohibit a commercial vendor from displaying prices of legal products by signs.
- e) To ensure compliance with subsections (b) and (c) above, random, unannounced inspections shall be conducted periodically by the Department of Public Safety or the Department of Health Services, or their designee(s), of retail or other establishments where alcoholic beverages, tobacco,

including but not limited to snuff, and controlled substances, 1 as defined in subsection (a) above, are manufactured, sold or 2 3 distributed. 4 Signs shall be prominently posted in all retail or other establishments where alcoholic beverages, tobacco 5 products, including but not limited to snuff, or controlled 6 7 substances, as defined in subsection (a) above, are sold or distributed, on which are printed the prohibitions and 8 penalties contained in subsection (b) above. The signs shall 9 10 be printed in Chuukese, or any local variation of Chuukese 11 spoken in the area where the establishment is located, and in English, in letters designed to be easily read, at least one-12 13 half inch high. Any person who violates the provisions of this subsection shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon 14 conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than \$100 per 15 offense, and shall be required to comply with the requirements 16 17 of this subsection immediately. 18 Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law 19 20 without such approval 21 22 Signed by KISANDELK!
