

AN ACT

To amend Section 1, III B(1)(d), D(2)(c)(ii) and E (2) of Chuuk State Law No. 3-95-17, as amended by Chuuk State Law No. 3-95-24, providing for Fiscal Year 1996 appropriations to provide a new alignment and specification of funds for Southern Namoneas and Weito, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 1, III B(1)(d), D(2)(c)(ii) and E (2) of Chuuk State Law No. 3-95-17, as amended by Chuuk State Law No. 3-95-24, is hereby further amended as follows:

"Section 1. The sum of \$10,381,822, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the State for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, for the purpose of funding Capital Improvement Projects in Chuuk State to be allocated as follows:






Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.


