ACT NO: 4-09

AN ACT

To appropriate \$8,208,120 from the General Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, for the purpose of funding the Capital Improvement Program, to prohibit reprogramming of funds, to provide for the obligation and continuation of the use of funds not obligated as of September 30, 1997, for reporting on the status of funds, revenues and expenditures; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

- Section 1. Capital Improvement Program. The sum of \$8,208,120, or so much
- 2 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
- 3 State for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, for the purpose of funding the
- 4 Capital Improvement Program. The Governor shall be the allottee of these funds.

                       Obligation and Continuation of Use of Funds.
22 appropriated under this Act shall be allotted, disbursed and administered pursuant
23 to law specifically including the State Financial Mangement Act, and the Contract
24 Bidding Law. Every allottee of funds under this Act shall be responsible to ensure
25 that the funds are used for the purposes they are appropriated for, and no
26 obligation of funds shall exceed the amounts appropriated. Except as specifically
27 provided in this Act, all funds not obligated by September 30, 1997 shall remain
28 available until fully expended.
         Section 4. Reporting. Every allottee of funds in this Act shall provide a

30 report on the status and specific use of the funds as of April 1, 1998, and no later
31 than April 15, 1998, to the Legislature or any appropriate committee thereof;
32 PROVIDED, that a supplemental report covering the actual use of all such funds for
33 the remainder of the fiscal year shall be provided by October 20, 1998.
