
To amend section 2 of Chuuk State Law No. 190-13, by providing for an increase of the departure fee from \$10.00 to \$15.00, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:


1 Section 1. Amendment. Section 2 of Chuuk State Law No. 190-13 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 2. Imposition of Fee. There is hereby levied or imposed, in addition to
4 all other fees of every kind, a departure fee of fifteen dollars (U.S \$15.00) per
5 passenger upon his or her departure from Chuuk State to any destination outside
6 of Chuuk State. All fees collected pursuant to this act shall be earmarked
7 exclusively for maintenance, renovations and expansion of the airport terminal
8 and other most relevant expenditure of the Chuuk International Airport."


9 Section 2. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon approval by the
10 Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.





AN ACT

To further amend Truk District Law No. 21-5, as amended by TDL No. 3-18, to increase the amount of the Diving Permit fees from \$3.00 to \$30.00, to specify the use of such fees, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Amendment. Section 5 of Truk District Law No. 21-5, as amended by
2 TDL No. 3-18, is hereby further amended to read as follows:


3 “Section 5. Permits to Examine.

4 (1) All persons who dive to or by any other means seek and obtain
5 access to the aforesaid ships, other vessels and aircraft, or any
6 and all parts thereof, for the purpose of examination shall first
7 obtain a permit therefor from the managers of the duly licensed
8 diving shops in the state, and no person may dive to or by any
9 other means seek and obtain access to the aforesaid ships, other
10 vessels and aircraft, or any and all parts thereof for the purpose
11 of examination without first obtaining a certified diving guide
12 from the duly licensed diving shops in the state. The managers
13 of the duly licensed diving shops are authorized to issue such
14 permits to those persons whom they deem qualified to conduct
15 such examination subject to such rules and regulations as the
16 Governor may prescribe.


17 (2) The managers of the duly licensed diving shops in the state
18 shall collect a thirty dollars (\$30.00) fee for each permit and
19 deliver the collected fees to the state treasury to be deposited in
20 the general fund. All fees collected pursuant to section 5 of
21 this act shall be earmarked exclusively for the administration,
22 protection, and development of Chuuk Lagoon State
23 monument.”

1 Section 2. Allottee. All funds collected pursuant to this act shall be allotted to the
 2 Governor of the State of Chuuk who shall be responsible to ensure that the fund is
 3 expended according to the purpose so specified and shall submit a report of the
 4 expenditure to the Legislature no later than September 30, 2000.


5 Section 3. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon approval by the
 6 Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.


