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AN ACT

To require Alcoholic Beverage Consumption Identification Cards for any person who purchases alcohol in Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

1           Section 1. Alcoholic Beverage Consumption Identification Card Required. No  
2 person in Chuuk State shall sell or give any alcoholic beverage to any other person unless  
3 the person to whom the alcoholic beverage is sold or given is then in immediate  
4 possession of a currently valid Alcoholic Beverage Consumption Identification Card,  
5 (hereinafter referred to as an I.D. Card), issued to the bearer as provided in this section.

6           Section 2. I.D. Card; Issuance.

7                   (a) I.D. Cards shall be issued by the State Director of Public Safety, or his  
8                   designee, upon the submission of a completed written application in  
9                   such form as shall be approved by the State Alcohol Beverage Control  
10                  Board, and upon his determination that the applicant meets all legal  
11                  requirements to be entitled to an I.D. Card.

12                  (b) The State Alcohol Beverage Control Board is authorized to require by  
13                  regulation such verifying evidence, as it deems necessary to establish  
14                  that an I.D. Card applicant meets all legal requirements to be entitled  
15                  to an I.D. Card.

16           Section 3. I.D. Card; Application; False Information.

17 No person shall give false information in obtaining or attempting to obtain an I.D. Card.  
18 nor shall any person in any way alter or deface a duly issued I.D. Card, nor shall any  
19 person allow any other person to use or possess his I.D. Card.

20           Section 4. I.D. Card; Contents.

21 I.D. Cards shall bear not less than the following:

- 22                   (a) Permittee's name;
- 23                   (b) Permittee's permanent address;
- 24                   (c) Permittee's place and date of birth;
- 25                   (d) Permittee's height, weight and color of hair and eyes;

- 1 (e) A recent photograph of the permittee (for "Regular" I.D. Cards only);  
2 (f) Permittee's signature;  
3 (g) An I.D. Card number;  
4 (h) Issuance and expiration date of the I.D. Card; and  
5 (i) Signature of the Director of Public Safety.

6 Section 5. I.D. Card; Types.

7 I.D. Cards shall be of two types, "Regular," valid for one calendar year from the date of  
8 issuance, and "Temporary," valid for 30 days from date of issuance. The issuance fee for  
9 a Regular I.D. Card shall be \$30.00, and the issuance fee for a Temporary I.D. Card shall  
10 be \$15.00. The issuance fee for a duplicate of lost or destroyed I.D. Card shall be \$10.00.

11 Section 6. I.D. Card; Issuance Fees Procedures.

12 All issuance fees for I.D. Cards shall be collected, accounted for and disbursed as  
13 follows:

- 14 (a) The State Director of Public Safety, or his designee, shall collect the  
15 prescribed fee for the issuance of all I.D. Cards in cash, at the time of  
16 issuance, and no I.D. Card shall be issued prior to collection of the issuance  
17 fee therefor.
- 18 (b) The Director of Public Safety shall maintain a separate ledger or ledgers in  
19 which shall be recorded all fees collected, along with a notation of the type of  
20 I.D. Card issued, the date issued, the date of expiration, the I.D. Card number  
21 and the name of the person to whom issued.
- 22 (c) All fees collected shall be turned over to the State Director of Treasury by the  
23 Director of Public Safety, not less than biweekly and shall be paid into the  
24 General Fund of Chuuk State.

25 Section 7. I.D. Card; Denial and Revocation.

26 Issuance of an I.D. Card shall be refused, or if already issued, such I.D. Card shall be  
27 revoked by order of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board as to any person who:

- 1 (a) Is under 21 years of age;
- 2 (b) Has been acquitted of any criminal charge by reason of insanity;
- 3 (c) Has been adjudicated mentally incompetent;
- 4 (d) Has been admitted as a patient in a hospital for drug addiction or alcoholism;
- 5 (e) Has been convicted, whether by plea of guilty or after trial, of any criminal
- 6 offense involving actual or attempted personal injury or death;
- 7 (f) Has misrepresented a material fact on his application to obtain or renew an
- 8 I.D. Card; or
- 9 (g) Has violated any provision of this section or any other section of this act or
- 10 any duly issued regulation of the State Alcohol Beverage Control Board.

11 Section 8. I.D. Card; Penalty. Any person who purchases, is in possession of, or

12 has consumed any alcoholic beverage not then having in his immediate possession a

13 currently valid Alcoholic Beverage Consumption I.D. Card, and any person who violates

14 sections 1 or 8 of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof

15 shall be fined not more than \$100.00 or imprisoned for not more than six (6) months or

16 both.

17 Section 9. I.D. Card; Religious Institutions.

18 Nothing in this section shall in any way limit or restrict the sale of sacramental wine to

19 bona fide religious denominations for use in religious services.

20 Section 10. I.D. Card; Annual Appropriation.


21 There is hereby authorized an annual appropriation of such funds as the Legislature may

22 determine from time to time is necessary for the operation of the alcoholic beverage


23 control program established in this act. The State Director of Public Safety, with the

1 approval of the State Alcohol Beverage Control Board, shall administer the funds  
2 appropriated under this act and shall purchase such supplies and equipment as are  
3 necessary to begin operation as required under this act.

4 Section 11. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon approval by the  
5 Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
