ACT NO: 6-17

AN ACT

To amend sections 8(Q), 9, 10 and 11(P) of Chuuk State Law No. 6-01-06, by reallocating the funding therein, correcting technical errors made thereto, reflecting other legal requirements in the use of regional funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Amendment. Section 8(Q) of Chuuk State Law No. 6-01-06 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 8. Operating Expenses of Other Programs. The sum of \$
4 6,875,399, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
5 General Fund of the State for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2002, for the purpose
6 of funding the operational expenses of Other State Programs. The Governor shall be the
7 allottee of the funds. The funds shall be apportioned as follows:

The sum of \$3,191,087, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the State for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2002, for the purpose of funding the operations of the SBG and Health and Medical. 11 from the general fund of the state for the purpose of funding the operations of the CIP

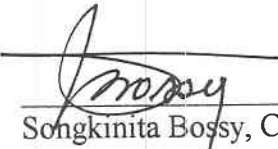

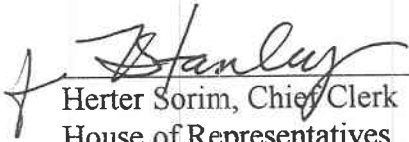

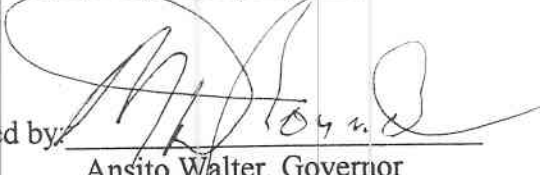
