ACT NO: 6-26

AN ACT

Amending section 1(b), of Chuuk State Law No. 2-94-21, by deleting parts of subsection (b) therein, to allow the use of any and all electronic poker machines in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

Section 1. <u>Amendment</u>. Subsection (b) of Section 1 of Chuuk State Law No. 2-94-21, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. <u>Defnitions</u>.

(b) "Games" or "gambling" means playing for money, property, checks, credit or any representative of value, including, without limiting the geerality of the foregong, faro, monte, reoulette, keno, bingo, fan-tan, twnety-one, blackjack, seven-and-a-half, big injun, klondike, craps, poker, chuck-a-luck, Chinese chuck-a-luck (daishu), chemin de fer, baccarat, pai gow, beat the banker, cock-fighting, ranuingui, any banking or percentage game, but does not include games played in private homes or residences in which no person makes money for playing such games."

Section 2. <u>Amendment</u>. A new section 6 to Chuuk State Law No. 2-94-21 is hereby established to read as follows:

"Section 6. Tax. A tax of \$2,5000.00 is hereby levied on every gambling

device, mechanical, electro or mechanical in the State of Chuuk.

Section 3. Effective Date. This act shall become effective upon approval of the

18 Governor or upon its otherwise becoming law without such approval.
