

AN ACT

Amending Section 3(b) of CSL NO. 191-12, the Chuuk State Scholarship Act of 1991, setting certain field of study priorities which the Board shall follow in its awards of scholarship, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Amendment. Section 3(b) of Chuuk State Law
2 No. 191-12 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 3. Duties and Functions. The
4 Scholarship Board shall have the power to select
5 qualified recipients to receive grants under this Act
6 and other scholarship grants from any source, and shall
7 exercise the following duties and responsibilities:

8 a) to receive and review all applications
9 for scholarship grants and determine the amount of the
10 awards;

11 b) to ensure that selection of awards is
12 based on the following field of study priorities as
13 determined by the Scholarship Board; which fields of
14 studies are limited to: 1) Law; 2) Medicine; 3)
15 Engineering; 4) Business and Accounting; 5) Marine
16 Studies; 6) Economics; 7) Agricultural development; 8)
17 Education; 9) Vocational Education; 10) Aviation; and
18 11) Other field of studies which the Scholarship Board
19 deems necessary and important for manpower needs and
20 development of the State as second priorities;"


21 c) to determine whether after a grant has
22 been awarded, the recipient shall continue to receive
23 the assistance grant in the amount necessary to
24 complete the educational or vocational program for
25 which the scholarship fund was awarded, or whether the

1 assistance grant shall be discontinued in the event the
2 recipient fails to maintain good standing in the
3 program;

4 d) to ensure that scholarships are awarded to
5 those Chuukese students who graduated from high
6 schools, both public and private, with commending
7 academic records, displaying good behavior and manner,
8 and showing serious efforts toward maintaining good
9 academic achievement; and


10 e) the Board shall have the power to
11 promulgate written rules and regulations for the
12 efficient implementation of this Act.

13 Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect
14 upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law
15 without such an approval.






