Dear President Mailo and Speaker Harper:

I am respectfully transmitting the attached Act 10 - 06 which I signed into a law and assigned the corresponding number as Chuuk State Law 10 - 09 - 05. This law amends sections 210 and 210(b) of CSL No. 3-95-18 requiring payment of annual registration fees for Chuuk State owned vehicles.


While I fully support the passage of this amendment, I am constrained to advise and seek your commensurate action to insert in our current FY 2010 appropriations request which is still under scrutiny, the amounts for the payment of the registration fees of all Chuuk State Government owned vehicles. For your information, the FY 2010 budget bill we requested does not contain any amounts of money for the annual registration of Chuuk State Government owned vehicles.

Unless and until, you pass insert in the FY 2010 Budget bill, the necessary amounts which corresponds to the registration fees for all Chuuk State Government owned vehicles embodied by this amendment, we might be facing shortage if not loss of transportation to all Chuuk State Government offices including critical services of the Department of Public Safety and ambulance of the Department of Health Services.

Lastly, this amendment does not include vehicles owned by the FSM National Government, including its agencies and the Municipal Governments which will defeat the purpose of this amendment that is to raise additional revenues. In view of this, I propose and request that this current amendment be further amended to include vehicles owned by the FSM National Government including its agencies and municipalities.

AN ACT

To amend sections 210 and 210 (b) of CSL No. 3-95-18 by applying registration fees to all government vehicles and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Chuuk State Legislature:

1 Section 1. Amendment. Sections 210 and 210 (b) of CSL No. 3-95-18 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 “Section 210. Government Vehicles. The registration requirements and registration fees
4 as provided for in section 205 of this Chapter shall apply to every vehicle owned by the Chuuk
5 State Government, except in the following particulars:


6 (a) A license plate issued for any vehicle while publicly owned need not display the year
7 number for which it is issued, but shall display a distinguishing symbol, word or
8 letter.

9 (b) The registration and registration card issued for any such vehicle shall be renewed
10 annually and remains valid until the certificate of ownership for the vehicle is
11 suspended, revoked or cancelled by the Director for cause or upon transfer of any
12 interest in the certificate of ownership. Provided, that registration fee shall be paid
13 annually. Upon any change in ownership, the vehicle shall be re-registered pursuant
14 to the provisions of this Chapter relating to any vehicle privately owned and the
15 special license plates previously issued for the vehicle while publicly owned shall be
16 surrendered to the office of the Director.

17 (c) The Director may suspend, cancel revoke or renew any permanent registration made
18 under this section when the Director determines that it is advisable to do so and
19 reissue any such registration under the same terms.”


20 Section 2. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor,
21 or upon its becoming law without such approval.
