ACT NO. 10-28

A SENATE BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$351,000.00 from the General Fund of the State for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, for the purpose of funding the Chuuk Department of Education's vocational training at the Guam Trades Academy and the Center for Micronesian Empowerment, and for other purposes.

Be It Enacted by the Chuuk State Legislature:

1 Section 1. Finding. It is the finding of the Legislature in furtherance of the
2 Memorandum of Understanding executed between the Chuuk State Government, through
3 its Department of Education, and the Guam Trades Academy (GTA) that it is within the
4 interest of the people of Chuuk that Chuuk State Government shall continue its
5 participation in the vocational training program at GTA. The initiative by Chuuk State
6 Government to pursue development of its workforce through GTA is also in line with the
7 FSM National Government's policy for the nation to take advantage of the economic
8 benefits from the military buildup in the US Territory of Guam.

9 Section 2. Appropriation. The sum of \$351,000.00, or so much thereof as may be
10 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Chuuk State Government
11 for the year ending September 30, 2010 for the purpose of funding Chuukese selected by
12 the Department of Education to attend or already enrolled in the vocational training
13 program at the Guam Trades Academy in coordination with the Center for Micronesian
14 Empowerment. The fund appropriated herein shall be deemed to have come from the
15 Supplemental Education Grant (SEG) for fiscal year 2006.


16 Section 3. Allottee. The Governor shall be the allottee of the sum appropriated
17 herein to be administered by the Director of the Department of Education who shall be
18 responsible to ensure that the fund is expended only for the purpose specified in Section 1
19 and in accordance with the Financial Management Act and other applicable laws, and
20 that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The fund appropriated
21 herein shall not lapse and shall remain available until fully expended.

22 Section 4. Reporting. The Governor shall submit a report to the Legislature on or
23 before September 30, 2010, which shall provide:

24 1. Full disclosure of the obligations incurred against the sum appropriated in
25 Section 1 and indicate the status of the fund as of April 15, 2011; and


26 2. the planned use of the balance of the fund not obligated as of April 15, 2011,
27 provided that a supplemental report covering the actual use and obligations of the fund
28 shall be submitted to the Legislature within 30 days after the closing of the fiscal year
29 2011.


30 Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the
31 Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.




