

Amending Section 10 of Article VI of the Chuuk State Constitution, providing for the incorporation to the people of Chuuk for the approval of the amendments, providing for its effectiveness and for other purposes.

Section 1. Amendment. Section 10 of Article VI of the Chuuk State Constitution is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 10. The powers, functions, and responsibilities in the executive departments shall be prescribed by statute."

Section 2. Effectivity. Pursuant to Section 2, Article XIV of the Chuuk State Constitution, this amendment shall be effective upon the approval of the people in the next general election by a majority of the votes cast on this amendment and by majority voices of all registered voters.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
