Dear President Mailo and Speaker Oneisom:

I am respectfully transmitting the attached Act 11 - 01, which I signed into a law and assigned the corresponding, number as Chuuk State Law No. 11 - 11 - 01. This law amends various sections of CSL No. 10-10-22, as amended by CSL Nos. 10-10-30 and 10-10-38 otherwise known as the FY 2011 Budget Act by increasing the local revenue budget from \$6,536,016 to \$6,671,712 or \$135,696, reprogramming from the unused of the personnel line item for various offices, departments and branches of Chuuk State, and appropriating the following:

- 1) \$180,000 for the Municipal Operations;
- 2) \$12,600 for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter allowance of the 12 new members of the House of Representatives;
- 3) \$65,000 for the travel of CSL;
- 4) \$13,100 for CSL Legal needs;
- 5) \$20,000 airport fuel;
- 6) \$5,000 for Guandong Delegation;
- 7) 10,000 for the travel of Governor's Office; and
- 8) 10,000 for the protocol of the Governor.

I have noticed discrepancies especially in the CSL budget. You have increased your travel to \$65,000 but there was an excess of \$1,800 on top of the \$65,000. In addition, the title of the bill including the transmittal states that the total increase in the Executive

Branch was \$70,000 but the line item reflects only \$40,000. Lastly, there was an increase of \$4,996 which our budget office could not determine which part of the budget was increased. This can be explained as follows:

I suggest that your budget office work with our budget office to determine where lies the difference of \$4,996.

Your efforts in the passage of this bill show your resilience despite of the tragedy that befalls the infrastructure of your institution.

## AN ACT

To further amend sections 1 to 7 and 10 of CSL No. 10-10-22, as amended by CSL Nos. 10-10-30 and 10-10-38 to reprogram and supplement the operations of the Executive, Legislative, and Judiciary branches of Chuuk State Government, to appropriate the sum of \$180,000 for the remaining six months of the Municipal operations, \$10,000 for the Election Commission, \$5,000 for the Guandong Delegation, \$12,600 for the allowance for one quarter of the new members of the House of Representatives, \$55,000 for the Committee travel of the Legislature and, \$10,000 for travel for the Office of the President and Speaker, \$13,100 for Legal Office needs, \$70,000 for the operations of the Executive Branch, to provide that appropriation for Municipal Operation shall be available until fully expended, to prohibit reprogramming and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Chuuk State Legislature:
