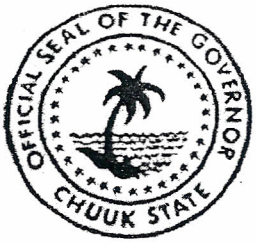
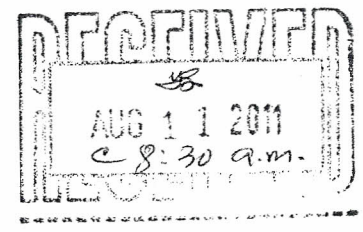

Dear President Mailo and Speaker Oneisom:

I am respectfully transmitting the attached Act 11-04 which I signed into a law and assigned the corresponding number as Chuuk State Law No. 11-11-04. This Act is the 5th amendment to the FY 2011 Budget Act. This amendment appropriates funding for the constitutionally mandated special election to be held on August 24, 2011.

I have noticed technical errors which I believe do not affect the substance of the Act 11-04 which are as follows:

- 1) The 1st page states, that this is "a senate bill for an act". This should be read as "An Act"; and
- 2) The 1st page in the title states that "and to provide \$10,000 for payment of outstanding salary of the March 2011". What about March 2011? What is the significance of that period?

The amount of \$70,071 of this appropriation came from the Infrastructure Maintenance Fund (IMF) which is our obligation pursuant to the Compact II. While I may agree with our priorities considering the special election is a mandate of

our Chuuk State Constitution we should be give equal importance to our Treaty obligations.

In view of this, I beseech you that we should work together to replenish the \$70,071 taken from the IMF as soon as possible.

AN ACT

To amend Sections 3, 4, 5 and 7 of Chuuk State Law No. 10-10-22, as amended by Chuuk State Law Nos. 10-10-30, 10-10-38, 11-11-01 and 11-11-03, by de-appropriating \$70,071 from the Infrastructure Matching Fund (IMF) which shall be immediately replenished by appropriation by the Legislature, 3,088 from Governor’s Office Personnel Cost and \$2,714 from Public Safety Director’s Personnel Cost, \$3,565 from Legislative Personnel Cost (~~\$57,000~~) from Legislative Contractual Services, and to appropriate the sum of \$126,438 to fund a special election in August 2011 for the office of Governor of the State of Chuuk, and to provide \$10,000 for payment of outstanding salary of the March 2011 General Election by adding subparagraphs new line items “Q” and “R”, under Section 7 and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Amendment. Section 3 of CSL No. 10-10-22, as amended by CSL Nos. 10-10-
2 30, 10-10-38, 11-11-01, and 11-11-03 by de-appropriating \$3,088 from Governor’s Office
3 Personnel Cost and to appropriate the same amount to supplement the cost of a special election
4 in August 2011 for the office of Governor of the State of Chuuk to read as follows:

5 Section 3. Operating Expenses of the Executive Branch. The sum of
6 \$21,103,967 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General
7 Fund of the State for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, for the purpose of funding the
8 internal operations of the Executive Branch of the Chuuk State Government. The Governor shall
9 be the allottee of these funds. These funds shall be apportioned as follows:
