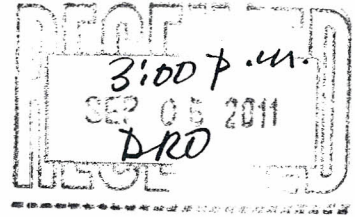

Dear President Mailo and Speaker Oneisom:

I am respectfully transmitting the attached Act 11-05, which I signed into a law and assigned the corresponding, number as Chuuk State Law No. 11-11-05. This law reprogrammed line items within the Legislature and allows the use of the Municipal operations until fully expended under section 7, other programs.

After I signed this Act and after advised from the Attorney General, I noticed that Section 2 of the Act was a substantial inconsistency to prior to this amendment to Section 7 of the FY 2011 budget act as amended. *Please find the attached marked as "1".*

The glaring inconsistencies and changes are as follows:



After consultation with your Legislative Counsel in which a written communication regarding the technical defects of what was transmitted which was not the intent of the 11<sup>th</sup> Chuuk State Legislature, I accepted the changes upon the advice of the Attorney General. *Please find the attached marked as "2"*. However, to legally correct the deficiency in the law, an amendment is required. I will be transmitting an amendment to Section 7, CSL 11-11-05 within this week.

AN ACT

To further amend Sections 4 and 7 of Chuuk State Law No. 10-10-22, as amended by Chuuk State Law Nos. 10-10-30, 10-10-38, 11-11-01, 11-11-03, and 11-11-04, to prevent funds appropriated in section 4, subsection 3 and section 7, subparagraph A from reverting back to the General Fund at the end of the fiscal year until expended, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Amendment. Section 4 of CSL No. 10-10-22, as amended by CSL Nos. 10-  
2 10-30, 10-10-38, 11-11-01, 11-11-03 and 11-11-04 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 4. Operating Expenses of the Legislative Branch. The sum of  
4 \$2,309,720 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
5 General Fund of the State for the Fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, for the purpose  
6 of funding the operation of the Legislative Branch of the Chuuk State Government.  
7 Funds appropriated under item number 3, hereunder shall remain available until fully  
8 expended. The President and the Speaker shall be the allottee of the funds. The funds  
9 shall be apportioned as follows:
