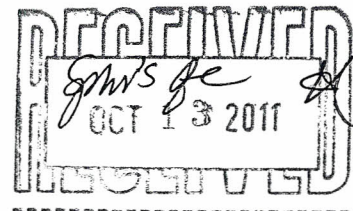

Dear President Mailo and Speaker Harper:

I am respectfully transmitting the attached Act 11-07 which I signed into a law and assigned the corresponding number as Chuuk State Law No. 11-11-07. This Act amended section 5 of TSL No. 4 - 59, as amended by CSL Nos. 2-94-14, 3-95-19, 4-98-36, 5-99-11, 5-00-29, 9-07-08 and 9-08-04 by placing Public Service System employees paid from local revenue sources on 72 hours biweekly workweek.

The Act is in line with the FY 2012 budget act which appropriates 72 hours pay for local revenue employees.

AN ACT

To further amend section 5 of TSL No. 4-59, as amended by CSL Nos. 2-94-14, 3-95-19, 4-98-36, 5-99-11, 5-00-29, 9-07-08, and 9-08-04 by increasing the locally funded employees to 72 hours pay periods, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Amendment. Section 5 of TSL No. 4-59, as amended by CSL Nos. 2-94-14,  
2 3-95-19, 4-98-36, 5-99-11, 5-00-29, 9-07-08 and 9-08-04, is hereby amended to read as follows:


3 "Section 5. Base Salary Schedule. Subject to section 17 (2) of the State Public  
4 Service System Act, the base hourly wage schedule appearing in the following table is  
5 hereby adopted pursuant to the State Public Service System Act to provide the official  
6 biweekly base salary. Except as provided under Section 10, all those locally funded  
7 employees must be paid on 72 hours biweekly pay period and 80 hours bi-weekly pay  
8 period, provided funds are available for foreign including compact sector grant  
9 employees which shall be paid to employees in accordance with the pay level assigned to  
10 their positions by the Public Service Commission under Section 17 (1) of the State Public  
11 Service System Act, as amended, and their respective terms of service in the position.  
12 The applicable amount set out below shall be paid to each employee who is in pay status  
13 for 80 or 72 hours in the biweekly pay period effective October 1, 2011. To determine  
14 the hourly rate for an employee who works fewer than 80 or 72 hours in a pay period or  
15 the hourly rate for overtime and applicable differentials, the applicable biweekly base  
16 salary shall be divided by 80 or 72. Such procedure shall be used only for those  
17 purposes, unless otherwise provided by law or regulation.




26           Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or
