

AN ACT

To establish a Development Authority for the Mortlock Islands, and to provide for its organization, management, authority and responsibility, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

1 Section 1. Establishment of Authority. The Mortlocks Development Authority (MDA) is
 2 hereby established as a public corporation under the laws of the State of Chuuk and the
 3 Federated States of Micronesia. The principal office of the authority shall be at a location
 4 determined by the Board.

5 Section 2. Area of Service. The Authority is hereby established to serve the following
 6 municipalities within the State of Chuuk:

- 7 (1) Nema
- 8 (2) Losap
- 9 (3) Piisemwar
- 10 (4) Namoluk
- 11 (5) Ettal
- 12 (6) Moch
- 13 (7) Kuttu
- 14 (8) Ta
- 15 (9) Satoan
- 16 (10) Oneop and
- 17 (11) Lekinioch

18 Section 3. Purpose of Authority. The Authority shall identify the development needs of
 19 its area of service and shall provide economic development activities in coordination and
 20 cooperation the State and National Governments.

21 Section 4. Board of Directors.

22 A. Establishment. There shall be a Board of Directors of the Mortlock Islands
 23 Development Authority which shall have general management and control over the authority;

24 B. Composition. The Board shall be composed of 13 members. One (1) from each of
 25 the eleven municipalities in the region to be appointed by the mayors and confirmed by the

1 respective municipal councils, the FSM Congress senator from the Mortlocks Region and a
2 representative to be appointed by the Governor of the State of Chuuk if any, to serve as ex-
3 officio member to only render technical advice to the body and shall not serve as an officer of the
4 Board.

5 C. Terms of Office. Terms of office of those members appointed by the
6 municipalities shall be for four years, except that the initial terms of office and filling of
7 vacancies shall be as provided in this act. The terms of office shall commence on the day of the
8 first meeting of the Board.

9 D. Organization Meeting. Not later than thirty days after the effective date of this act,
10 the Board shall meet to select its officers and conduct such other business as it shall deem
11 advisable. At the first meeting, the members of the Board representing the municipalities shall
12 determine by lot the length of their initial terms as follows: Five for two years, four for three
13 years and four for four years. The first meeting of the Board shall be called by the Governor's
14 representative, or if there is one, or by the Chairman of the Mortlocks Advisory Council, who
15 shall preside at the first meeting until the officers have been elected, pursuant to subsection (7) of
16 this section.

17 E. Vacancies. Each vacancy on the Board shall be filled to serve out the unexpired
18 term in the same manner as originally filled. Upon a determination that a vacancy exists, the
19 Chairman or, in his absence, the presiding officers of the Board shall issue a notice of vacancy to
20 all members of the Board and to the municipality responsible for filling the vacancy.

21 F. Removal.

22 1) Members of the Board may be removed from office, for failure to attend three
23 consecutive meetings of the Board, or for incompetence, neglect of duty, or malfeasance in
24 office.

25 2) Removal of a member, except for failure to attend three consecutive meetings
26 (which does not need a vote of the board), shall be by a three fourths majority vote of all other
27 members of the Board. Notification of intent to call for the removal of a member pursuant to this
28 section shall be made at least thirty days in advance, and shall include a summary of the
29 allegation against a member including the names of witnesses and evidences to be call and used
30 against such a member.

31 G. Officers. The Board shall elect from among its members a Chairman, Vice
32 Chairman and a Secretary-Treasurer.

1 H. Regular Meetings. Regular meetings shall be held not less than once in one
2 calendar quarter, at such time and place as may be from time to time be determined by the
3 Chairman upon notice as may be provided.

4 I. Special Meetings. Special meetings may be called by the Chairman on his
5 initiative, or by a petition by one third of the members.

6 J. Quorum. A quorum to legally transact business of the Board shall consist of seven
7 members of the Board, representing the municipalities in the Mortlocks Island Region.

8 K. Records of Meetings. All meetings of the Board shall be public except when
9 confidential matters relating to personnel are discussed. The Secretary-Treasurer shall be
10 responsible and to ascertain that all records of the Board meetings are maintained and readily
11 made available for public inspection at reasonable times and places.

12 L. Powers of the Authority. The Authority, through its Board of Directors shall have
13 the following powers, obligations and duties:

14 (1) To identify the needs for the economic, educational and other social development
15 of the areas served by the authority, taking into account the cultural and social traditions of the
16 area;

17 (2) To formulate plans and goals for the development of the resources of the area;

18 (3) To seek from all appropriate sources funds for the implementation of such plans;

19 (4) To administer programs and projects in furtherance of such developmental goals,
20 either through its employees or by contract, or such other means as the Board deems advisable;

21 (5) To employ an Executive Director and a Budget and Finance Officer, and to set the
22 terms of employment and to employ such administrative staff and other employees as may be
23 required by law or deemed by the Board to be needed in furtherance of the goals of the
24 Authority;

25 (6) To acquire in any lawful manner any property, real, personal, or mixed, tangible,
26 or any interest therein, to hold, maintain and use the same; and to sell, lease or otherwise dispose
27 of the same at such time, manner, and to the extent deemed necessary to the Board to carry out
28 its purposes;

29 (7) To establish, maintain, operate, and engage in, upon its own account, any
30 appropriate enterprise, undertaking, or activities in furtherance of the purpose of the Authority;
31 and to receive payments thereof, such payment to go into the general revenues of the authority;

1 (8) To enter into and perform such contracts or other agreements or transactions as
2 may be necessary in the conduct of its business and such terms as it may deem appropriate;

3 (9) To borrow money from time to time; provided however, that the debts of the
4 authority shall not be debts of the State of Chuuk or any of its political subdivisions; the assets of
5 the State Government or its political subdivisions shall not be used as security for the debts of
6 the Authority, unless otherwise provided by law;

7 (10) To levy and collect charges, fees, and other payments for goods sold and services
8 rendered by the authority, except that no such levy shall be in the form of a tax or assessment
9 levied against the general public, the users of public facilities, or property benefitted by actions
10 of the Authority unless specifically authorized by law;

11 (11) To execute all instruments necessary or appropriate in the exercise of its powers;

12 (12) To take such other actions and assume such other responsibilities as may be
13 necessary or appropriate to carry out the duties conferred to it by law; and

14 (13) To approve bylaws, policies and procedures for the guidance and operation of the
15 Authority.

16 Section 5. Management.

17 (1) The Authority, through the Board, may receive, manage, invest, and disburse
18 funds or other property which may be appropriated, granted, or in any other manner received
19 from any source for the purpose of the Authority. The Authority may use governmental
20 accounting procedure or if appropriate, such financial or accounting system as may be prescribed
21 by law for commercial companies.

22 (2) The Authority may purchase supplies, equipment and materials through its own
23 purchasing procedure or governmental purchasing procedures as it may deem appropriate.

24 Section 6. Annual Budget. The Executive Director shall prepare and submit a budget for
25 approval by the Board of Directors for the Authority's annual operation.

26 Section 7. Executive Director. There shall be an Executive Director of the Authority, who
27 shall be appointed by Board and serve at its pleasure. The Board shall establish the salary of the
28 Executive Director. The Executive Director shall be responsible for management of the
29 programs, projects and other activities of the Authority and shall employ, supervise and
30 terminate employees of the Authority in accordance with the general terms and rules of the
31 employment by the Board, except as provided in section 10 of this act.

1 Section 8. Budget and Finance Officer. The Executive Director shall appoint, with the
2 concurrence of the Board, a Budget and Finance Officer for such term as may be provided. The
3 Budget and Finance Officer shall receive and disburse all funds of the Authority. The Budget and
4 Finance Officer shall serve at all times under the direct supervision of the Executive Director.

5 Section 9. Accounts and Records. The Board and the Executive Director shall be jointly
6 responsible to ensure that the Budget and Finance Officer prepares proper and complete books of
7 accounts reflecting all income, expenditures, assets, and liabilities of the authority, including
8 appropriations, grants and property. The Board, not later than sixty days after the close of each
9 governmental fiscal year, shall submit to the Governor and the presiding officers of the
10 Legislature a complete report showing the activities of the Authority during the fiscal year, the
11 present condition of the Authority and such other matters as the Board shall deem appropriate.
12 The State Public Auditor or a licensed accountant appointed by the Board shall inspect and audit
13 all the accounts and book of the Authority at least annually, and report thereon to the Governor
14 and the Legislature.

15 Section 10. Taxation and the Authority. To the extent that the legislative capacity of the
16 State of Chuuk can prescribe, the Authority shall be treated as a governmental entity and shall be
17 exempted from tax in the same manner as a governmental entity with regard to its functions that
18 are governmental in nature. With respect to functions that the Authority may undertake that are
19 commercial in nature, as that function is currently exercised by the government of the State of
20 Chuuk or its subdivisions the Authority shall be treated as a non-profit commercial enterprise.

21 Section 11. Personnel Administration.

22 (1) The Authority may establish its own personnel system and policies, independent of
23 the Chuuk State Public Service System; or may, by appropriate resolution of the Board addressed
24 to the Governor, be included in the Chuuk State Public Service System for purposes of its
25 personnel administration; provided that, if the Authority chooses to be included in the State
26 Public Service System, the Board may designate from time to time such positions as it deems
27 appropriate to be exempted from that system.

28 (2) All employees of the Authority, including the Executive Director and the Budget
29 and Finance Officer, if members of the Chuuk State Public Service System immediately prior to
30 their employment with the Authority, shall continue to accrue such rights as their seniority
31 entitles them during employment with the Authority.


1 (3) The Board may, by general rules applicable to all employees, assign to such
2 employees levels of wages and benefits that take into account, in whole or in part, their prior
3 governmental employment.

4 (4) The Chuuk State Government shall provide to all former employees of the
5 Authority, who shall have terminated their employment in good standing, such rights of
6 employment and seniority as their service to the Authority, as well as prior government service,
7 would entitle them as if all such service were with the Chuuk State Government or the Trust
8 Territory Government.


9 Section 12. Notification to Municipal Governments Regarding Projects. The
10 Authority shall endeavor to inform affected municipal governments of any projects planned for
11 their communities at the earliest practical opportunity and shall continue to inform them and
12 members of the public of the nature of the projects and any substantial changes in their plans.


13 Section 13. Repealer. All laws or parts thereof that are in conflict with this Act are
14 repealed to the extent of the conflict.

15 Section 14. Effective Date. The Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor or
16 upon it otherwise becoming law without such approval.


