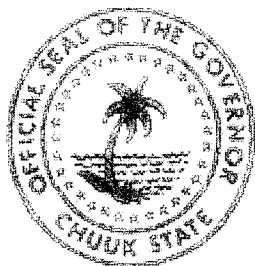
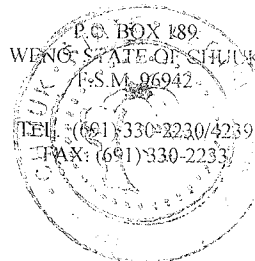


I am transmitting your Act 13-12 which I have partially signed into law and is designated as our Chuuk State Law No 13-16-03. At the outset, I want to point out from my perspective that since the subject Act involves the proposed uses of money, (our \$2.7 million infrastructure grant from the FSM), it is an "appropriation" within the meaning of Article 5 Section 14(c) of our Chuuk State Constitution and is therefore subject to item veto.

Accordingly, I have signed into law the entire Act except that I have decided to item veto Section 1 B relating the funding for Design and Engineering Plan for the COM Chuuk Campus Access Road. Please be assured that my item veto does not suggest any fundamental disagreement with the Legislature; it is rather a matter of economics for our state given the scattered sources of our infrastructure financial resources. I have decided to item veto your proposed use of part of the \$2.7 million grant for the COM road because our state has already requested the PMU for a Job Change Order to include construction of the said COM road in the current construction of the Weno Road Project.

In addition, since the PMU has not acted on our request, I have also instructed our State Budget Office to earmark in our FY17 Budget proposal our FY15 and FY16 share of the FSM Compact Infrastructure grant as funding donation for construction of the COM Chuuk campus, including the specific access road. As you know, our shares from the FSM's infrastructure grant have been allotted by OIA into our Chuuk State unallocated account with the requirement that its use be based on the Compact priorities for education and health uses. Our funding donation to the COM Chuuk Campus satisfies that priority requirement. I therefore ask that the Legislature re-designates the fund under Section 1B

for our general road improvement project without specifying its exclusive use for the design and plan of the COM Campus road. I trust that you will understand my reason behind the item veto of the Section 1 B. I look forward to further collaboration between our two branches.

AN ACT

To authorize funding of specific projects from the \$2,750,000.00, provided by the FSM Congress under Public Law No. 19-32, for Chuuk State's Priority Infrastructure Projects, and for other purposes.

1 Section 1. Authorization. Chuuk State Priority Infrastructure Projects Bldg.
2 Development fund of \$2,750,000.00 appropriated by the FSM Congress under Public Law No.
3 19-32, Section 9(12)(a)(ii) is hereby authorized for acquisition of the following project sites
4 based on the ADB land valuation rates, and public road improvement as recommend by the
5 Infrastructure Projects Implementation Commission (IPIC):


20 Section 2. Documentation. Prior to appropriation of funds by the Legislature for the
21 above priority projects, the Governor shall submit to the Legislature the following documents.

- 22 1. For land acquisition, documents shall include evidence of title, leasehold
23 agreements, purchase agreements or other legal authority for use of land upon which the
24 infrastructure project(s) is to be constructed.

1 2. For constructing project, documents shall include description of the
 2 project and how it relates to the objectives and goals in the State's IDP, scope of work that
 3 describes the work to be performed and the schedule from planning of costs through completion
 4 of construction and detailed budget for each project. The budget shall include a breakdown of
 5 costs (in-house and contracts) for planning, real property design and engineering, construction,
 6 construction management and inspection. A certified professional engineer shall sign both the
 7 scope of work and budget for each construction project.


8 Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor or
