

I thank you for your commitment to the financial stability of our state, demonstrated in our enactment of our attached state law, CSL No. 13-16-15, which re-extends the deadline for our state to borrow money for payments of our existing state debts. I have now referred the new law to the Borrowing Task Force to continue searching for a willing lender. (The Task Force consists of the DAS Director, Budget Officer, Attorney General and Special Assistant to the Governor for Financial Matters). I ask that the Legislature continues to explore means of enhancing capability as well as reducing our overall state debts portfolios.

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ACT NO. 13-26

AN ACT

Further amending Chuuk State Law No 12-14-25 as previously amended by CSL 13-15-04 by further extending the deadline by which the Governor may secure a borrowing as authorized, by delineating the general kinds of state debts to be paid by any loan proceeds secured thereunder, and for other purposes.

Section 1. Amendment. Section 6 of CSL 12-14-25 as previously amended by CSL 13-

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CHUUK STATE LEGISLATURE:

- 15-04 is hereby further amended to read as follows: 2 "Section 6. Negotiation. The Governor shall have up to the end of September 30, 2017 3 to negotiate and secure a loan agreement under this Act, including securing the 4 endorsement of the FSM National Government if such is required for the approval of the 5 borrowing." In negotiating and securing the loan for the purposes authorized hereunder, 6 the Governor shall service the debts with such loan proceeds based on these payments 7 priorities, recognizing that some of these delineated debts gain judgment lien priorities 8 after the State entered into a Financial Reform and Management MOU with the FSM on 9 retiring of the debts in 2007: 10
 - The Chuuk State 1999 Airport loan with the municipalities (\$3 million principal + \$3.7 million interest at 5% per annum) in FSM Supreme Court Civil Action No 2012-1024, Eot Municipality, et al. v. Governor Johnson Elimo and Chuuk State, and two other related cases;
 - 2. The \$1.5 million Chuuk State Employees' 1986-1987 COLA Judgment;
 - 3. The FY14 audited outstanding Chuuk State land purchase debt of \$8 million in principal;
 - Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Act shall become law upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
