PUBLIC LAW NO. 11-1

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL GRANT-IN-AID FUND

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE, THAT:

Section 1. There is authorized to be appropriated annually a sum not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) for the purpose of providing grant-in-aid to the municipalities to assist them in financing the construction of municipal offices, dispensaries and walls to stop salt water from running into taro lands.

Section 2. The District Administrator is hereby authorized to administer any funds appropriated pursuant to Section 1 of this Act. He shall establish requirements and procedures for obtaining and utilizing grant-in-aid in accordance with the provisions of this Act.
