## PUBLIC LAW NO. 12 - 11

## AN ACT APPROPRIATING GENERAL REVENUES OF THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE FOR COMPENSATION OF COKKS FOR PUBLIC AND NON-PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE, THAT:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the Truk District Legislature, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$3,000.00 for compensation of cooks for public and non-public lementary schools receiving USDA foods.

Section 2. All cooks eligible under this act shall be paid 5.00 per person per month by the Treasurer of the Truk District Leg-slature, upon certification submitted to the Treasurer by the magistates and/or principals for these schools.

Section 3. There shall be one cook for every 100 students of school; those schools which have less than 100 students each, shall are one cook.
