## PUBLIC LAW NO. 12-13

## ACT AMENDING PUBLIC LAW NO. 3-5, REORGANIZATION OF THE TRUK DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE, THAT:

Section 2, Paragraphs 1,2, and 3 of Public Law No. 3-5 shall be mended in its entirety to read as follows:

"The Board shall consist of thirteen(13) members; one (1) of whom shall be the District Educational Administrator, who shall be an ex-officio member as designated by Section 569 of the Trust Territory Code; twelve (12) of whom shall be appointed by the Trust District Legislature, subject to approval of the District Administrator.

"The term of office of appointed members of the Board shall be two (2) years. Half of the appointments shall be made in one (1) year and the other half in the succeeding year. Appointments shall be made during the first session of the Legislature of the calendar year.

"Each member who attends a meeting shall be paid \$4.00 per meeting by the District Treasurer, provided, however, meeting of the said Board shall not exceed six (6) times a year."
