PUBLIC LAW NO. 12-5

AN ACT APPROPRIATING GENERAL REVENUES OF THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE IN  
SUPPORT OF TRUKESE PURSUING IN-SERVICE EDUCATION IN ANY FIELD OF STUDY IN  
THE TRUST TERRITORY AND ON GUAM

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE, THAT:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the Truk District Legislature for fiscal year 1966, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,000.00 for the following purposes:

Appropriation required to pay costs involved in housing and other living expenses of Trukese pursuing in-service education in any field of study in the Trust Territory and on Guam.

Section 2. The support stated hereinabove shall be made only when an applicant is granted a dependent allowance and school credit hours by the Trust Territory Government.
