## AM ACT OF THE SIXTH CONGRESS, 1962

## PUBLIC LAW NO. 6 - 7

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THE PAYABERT OF A STIPEND FOR TEACHER TRAINEES

BE IT ENACTED by the Sixth Congress in legislature assembled, That

Section 1. A stipend of ten dollars (10.00) per month or fraction therecrounded to the nearest whole quarter month, shall be paid to those attending teacher-training programs approved by the District Department of Education, crowided:

- (a) the trainee is not already on the Congress payroll as a teacher at the time of training;
- (b) there has been no opportunity at training time for the Education Department to communicate with the municipality in which the trainee is proposed for employment by the Education Department, and
- (c) the trainee agrees to refund all payments made under this law should he refuse to accept employment as an elementary teacher, except when a trainee is withdrawn for accepting any scholarship.
- Section 2. The stipend shall stop in the event of hiring during the training period, since they will then go on the Congress payroll.
- Section 3. The stipend may be continued after the training period while trainee is necessarily waiting for transportation to the proposed municipality. This is at the discretion of the Education Department and in no case shall be made:
  - (a) if the trainee accepts temporary employment while waiting, or
  - (b) for a period greater than six weeks after the end of the training.
