
ENACTING THE TRUK DISTRICT CODE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE THAT:

Section 1. Statement of Intent. This enactment of the Truk District Code is intended to effect a codification of the general and permanent laws of Truk District and is not intended to effect any substantive changes therein.

Section 2. Enactment. The manuscript known as the Truk District Code, and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby enacted as law effective August 1, 1971, and designated as "The Truk District Code".

Section 3. Repeal. The enactment of this Code in no way repeals prior uncodified enactments or enactments which are codified. Where this Code fails to incorporate active prior law, prior law shall continue to have the force of primary law. Any inconsistencies between this Code and provisions of Public Law shall be resolved in favor of Public Law. This Code shall be considered prima facie evidence of current law unless inconsistency with prior law, or exclusion of prior law, can be demonstrated, in which case prior law shall be considered current law.

Section 4. Supplements as Part of Code. The law contained in any current pocket parts or supplements to this Code, printed and published under contract or otherwise as may be authorized by law, constitutes prima facie, a part of this Code if the laws, as so contained, propose to represent reproductions of statutory amendments or additions to this Code.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the District Administrator, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
