

TWENTY-FIRST REGULAR SESSION, 1971

APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$4,000 OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND OF THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENABLING MEMBERS OF THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE TO ATTEND AND OBSERVE REGULAR SESSIONS OF THE GUAM LEGISLATURE, CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA, AND LEGISLATURES IN OTHER DISTRICTS OF THE TRUST TERRITORY OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS DURING FISCAL YEAR 1972, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE THAT:

Section 1. Appropriation. The sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the Truk District Legislature not otherwise appropriated for fiscal year 1972, for the purpose of enabling members of the Truk District Legislature to attend and observe regular sessions of the Guam Legislature, Congress of Micronesia, and Legislatures of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands.

Section 2. Selection of Legislators. The Speaker of the Truk District Legislature is hereby authorized to select members of the Legislature to attend sessions of the aforementioned legislative bodies. The Speaker shall select different persons to attend each of the different legislative bodies.

Section 3. Priorities and Duration of Attendance. The Speaker of the Truk District Legislature shall determine priorities from amongst the legislative bodies which legislators are hereby authorized to attend. He shall also determine the length of time for which legislators will be authorized to visit the legislative bodies.

Section 4. Submission of Reports. All members of the Truk District Legislature who attend and observe the designated legislative bodies shall submit written and oral reports of the activities of such legislative bodies following their return to the Truk District.

Section 5. Allowance. The Speaker is hereby authorized to have the District Treasurer provide per diem and transportation payments and also pay each legislator attendee \$15.00 for each workign day of the legislative body at which he is in attendance. Per diem shall be in accordance with the rates established by the Trust Territory for the various locations.

Section 6. Effective Date: This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the District Administrator, or upon its otherwise becoming law without such approval.
