AMENDING SECTION 2 AND 3 OF PUBLIC LAW 20-2 RELATING TO THE MUNICIPAL POLICE  
SUBSIDIES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE THAT:

Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law 20-2: Section 2 of Public Law 20-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Appropriation: There is hereby appropriated the sum of ten thousand nine hundred fifty dollars (\$10,950.00) out of the General Fund of the Truk District Legislature not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of subsidizing municipal police salaries."

Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law 20-2. Section 3 of Public Law 20-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. Distribution. The funds appropriated pursuant to this act shall be allocated as follows:

Section 3. Subsidy. The Municipal police who are selected and approved by the municipal magistrate and the municipal council of each municipality, shall upon compliance with Section 4 of this act, be eligible to receive subsidy, except as provided in Section 6 of this act, as the municipal magistrate in conjunction with the municipal council deem necessary and appropriate to carry out the purposes of this Act, from the amount allocated for each municipality in Section 2 of this Act.

Section 4. Report. The magistrate of each municipality, upon the express consent of the municipal council, shall transmit or cause to be transmitted the name (s) of the municipal police from his municipality to the Chief of Police, Truk, with a courtesy copy to the District Treasurer, not later than thirty days after the effective date of this Act. The transmission shall also include, in addition to the names of policemen, their home island, and their village. Each of the municipal police who is qualified to receive subsidy pursuant to this act shall keep a journal of his daily work. He shall then compile these daily reports during the last week of each

month and submit the same to either the magistrate or the community court judge of his municipality for certification. Upon certification, the municipal magistrate shall transmit the monthly report to the Chief of Police, Truk, who shall then notify the District Treasurer that the municipal police officer has complied with the provisions of this Section. The Chief of Police, at the same time, shall request the District Treasurer to disburse the fund allocated to the municipality to the municipal magistrate, or his designated representatives, who shall co-sign the request.

Section 5. Disbursement. The District Treasurer is hereby authorized to disburse the fund appropriated by this act upon receipt of a request therefor made under the provisions of Section 4 of this Act. Only the field trip officer is authorized to distribute the subsidies for municipal police to municipalities located in the outer islands of Truk District.

Section 6. Disqualification. Noncompliance with Section 4 of this act shall be sufficient ground for any municipal police officer to be disqualified from receiving subsidy. If a municipal policeman resigns, dies, or is removed for cause, the municipal magistrate shall immediately notify the District Chief of Police of the same. Death, resignation, removal for cause, or service on an island other than the island of his permanent residence shall automatically and immediately disqualify a police officer from receiving subsidy under this act.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the District Administrator, or upon its otherwise becoming law without such approval.
