TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$45,000) OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND OF THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE, NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PUBLIC MUSEUM AT THE TRUK AIR TERMINAL AREA, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE THAT:

Section 1. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated the sum of forty five thousand dollars (\$45,000) out of the General Fund of the Truk District Legislature, not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of constructing a Public Museum at the site of the former Truk Air Terminal Building which was destroyed by Typhoon Amy in May 1971. The money appropriated herein shall remain available until expended at the direction of the District Administrator.

Section 2. Administration. The District Administrator, or his designated representative, is the administrator of the funds appropriated under Section 1 of this Act and is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into contract agreement with the U.S. Federal Government or its representative, or any individual, group, or corporation, as he deems necessary, to cause the construction of the Public Museum either in conjunction with or independent from the construction of the Truk Air Terminal Building financed by the U.S. Federal Government.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon
