

SEVENTY-FIRST REGULAR SESSION, 1971

AUTHORIZING AN ANNUAL APPROPRIATION OF SUCH SUMS AS THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE MAY DEEM NECESSARY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING A PILOT PROJECT IN VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE THAT:

Section 1. Appropriation Authorization. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated annually out of the General Fund of the Truk District Legislature, not otherwise appropriated, such sums as are necessary to carry out the purposes of this act.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the Vocational Scholarship Program shall be to enable qualified Trukese men and women, of whatever educational level, to receive scholarship funds and attend vocational training programs whatever they are offered. The money appropriated hereunder shall be used only for scholarships in programs of vocational instruction.

Section 3. Administration. The Economic Development Officer shall administer the funds appropriated hereunder. The Economic Development Officer shall locate vocational programs and shall elect qualified students upon recommendation of qualified sources in the community, to receive scholarship grants. The Economic Development Officer shall also determine how much should be granted for each scholarship and shall keep records on the progress of each recipient.

Section 4. Distribution. The District Treasurer shall be responsible to distribute the funds appropriated hereunder. Upon notification by the Economic Development Officer, the District Treasurer shall disburse these funds.

Section 5. Report. Prior to each regular session of the Legislature, the Economic Development Officer shall submit a report to the Legislature. The report shall discuss the progress of the \_\_\_\_\_ year. The report shall also identify manpower requirements for the following year and training programs which can fit the manpower needs. The report shall finally recommend a level of funding for the following year.

Section 6. Effective Date. This act shall become effective upon its approval by the District Administrator, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
