TO COMPENSATE THE VICE-SPEAKER; TO PROVIDE FOR COMPENSATION OF THE ACTING SPEAKER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE THAT:

Section 1. <u>Amendment</u>. Title 21 of Chapter 5 of the Truk District Code is hereby amended by deleting the present subsections 101.1, 101.2 and by adding new subsections 101.1, 101.2 and 101.3 to read as follows:

- " § 101.1 <u>Acting Speaker.</u> Any member of the Truk District Legislature who has officially been designated Acting Speaker shall receive twenty-eight (\$28.00) dollars per day or three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50) per hour actually worked, whichever is less, for each day he assumes the position of Acting Speaker of the Truk District Legislature at times other than when the Legislature is in session. "
- " \$ 101.2 <u>Vice-Speaker.</u> The Vice-Speaker shall receive a monthly allowance of seventy-five (\$75.00) dollars; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, any month he assumes the position of Acting Speaker he shall receive the monthly allowance or the designated amount for serving as Acting Speaker, whichever is greater. "
- " \$ 101.3 <u>Duties of Vice-Speaker to be Designated</u>. The Speaker and the Vice-Speaker shall meet not less than once each calendar year to discuss the duties of the Vice-Speaker. After discussion, the Speaker shall designate the various duties and responsibilities required of the Vice-Speaker."

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the District Administrator, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
