TWENTY-SECOND REGULAR SESSION, FIRST SPECIAL SESSION, 1972 ACT NO. 22-1-7

AN ACT

AMENDING TRUK DISTRICT LAW 22-20 TO ALLOW TWO MEMBERS OF THE TRUK DISTRICT TOURIST COMMISSION TO BE ASSOCIATED WITH ANY TOURIST RELATED INDUSTRY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE THAT:

Section 1. Section 32 of Truk District Law 22-20 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"§ 32. Membership. The Tourist Commission shall consist of seven voting members, who shall be appointed by the District Administrator with the advice and consent of the Speaker of the Truk District Legislature. All members shall be citizens of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands and residents of Truk District. The District Administrator shall not appoint more than two members who are the owner, agent, or employee of any hotel, restaurant, travel agency, airline or any other organization which derives a major portion of its income from tourism."

Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the District Administrator, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
