AN ACT

ESTABLISH A TRUK DISTRICT CIVIC ACTION TEAM COORDINATION COMMITTEE; TO FORTH ITS DUTIES AND FUCTIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE THAT:

Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. There is hereby established a Truk District Livic Action Team Coordination Committee for the purpose of serving as a made and advisor to the Officer-in-Charge of the Civic Action Team in Truk Listrict. The Coordination Committee, through the Officer-in-Charge of the Civic Action Team, shall provide basic guidance and advice to members of the said Civic Action Team assigned to Truk District on any all projects of the Civic Action Team.

Section 2. Membership. There shall be five (5) members of the Coordination Committee, two (2) of whom shall be members of the District Legislature and be appointed by the Speaker of the Truk District Legislature two (2) by the District Administrator. The fifth member shall come from Civic Action Team. Each member, except the Speaker and the District Legislature two may serve as ex-officio members of the Coordination Committee thout the right to vote, shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing licial. At its initial organizational meeting, to be called by the Speaker

of the Truk District Legislature, the Coordination Coordination Committee, shall elect its officers consisting of a Chairman and any other officers the membership deems necessary to carry out their duties and functions effectively.

Section 3. Meeting-Quorum. The Coordination Committee shall hold as many meetings as the Chairman may deem necessary to transact business of the Coordination Committee. Three voting members present at a meeting shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of transacting business.

Section 4. <u>Duties-Powers</u>. The Coordination Committee shall have the authority to review all requests for assistance submitted by municipalities to the Civic Action Team. Upon reviewing such requests, the Committee shall then determine the priority in providing the needed assistance depending upon the urgency of each request. The committee may then recommend the termination or reassignment of the members of the Civic Action Team within Truk District.

Section 5. Compensation-Members. The members of the Coordination

Committee shall be entitled to compensation at the rate established by the

Truk District Legislature for members of Boards and committees when actually

performing the duties and functions of the Coordination Committee, as

approved by the Chairman, except that those members who are employed by the

Trust Territory Government shall instead receive their regular salaries while

performing the duties and functions of the Coordination Committee.
