AN ACT

APPROPRIATING SIX HUNDRED (\$600.00) DOLLARS TO PROVIDE NECESSITIES FOR THE THREE CHILDREN OF A TRUKESE MAN KILLED JUNE 4, 1972; TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE FINDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE THAT:

Section 1. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the Truk District Legislature, the sum of six hundred (\$600.00) dollars to provide necessities for Kindino. Roman and Bunian, the three children of Enias Rekech, who was killed during the storm of June 4, 1972.

Section 2. Administration. The District Treasurer shall disburse out of the money herein appropriated an amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00) on the last day of each week of every month to Legislator Candido Michael who shall then deliver the same to the children concerned to assist them in their needs in the area of food, clothing, and other necessities. He shall upon his becoming aware of any additional needs of Kinidino, Roman and Bunian prepare a report stating:

- (1) the name (S) of the child or children concerned;
- (2) the nature of their needs;
- (3) an estimate of the amount needed to take care of the need; and

(4) the manner in which this amount will be spent.

be shall then sign this report and present it to the District Treasurer who shall disburse the amount of additional funds requested; provided, however, no funds shall be disbursed in excess of the amount herein allocated.

Section 3. Availability of Fund. The funds herein appropriated shall remain available until expended.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Truk District Administrator, or upon its otherwise becoming law without such approval.
