
AN ACT

TO APPROPRIATE THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00) AS FUNDS TO MATCH A GRANT OF FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) TO ESTABLISH A BOY SCOUT PROGRAM IN TRUK DISTRICT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE THAT:

SECTION 1. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the Truk District Legislature the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) for the purpose of providing matching funds for a grant of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) to be provided by the Aloha Council of the Boy Scouts of America to be used to establish a Boy Scout Program in Truk District.

Section 2. Administration. The District Administrator or his designee shall assist the Aloha Council in the administration of the funds herein appropriated and in the appointment of a director and a supervisor for the program. Upon receipt in Truk District of the five thousand dollar (\$5,000.00) grant from the Aloha Council, the District Treasurer shall disburse the funds herein appropriated to the District Administrator or his designee.

Section 3. Reversion of Funds. Any funds appropriated by this act remaining unexpended and unobligated on June 30, 1974, shall revert to the General Fund of the Truk District Legislature.

Section 4. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its approval by the District Administrator, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
