ACT NO. 27-1-1

AN ACT

Defining residence for purposes of voting in district elections and eligibility for public office, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE THAT:

Section 1. Residence-voters and public officials.

- (1) To determine eligibility to vote in district elections and for public office in the District Government, residence means a place a person has a fixed abode or domicile.
- (2) Registration of residence in a municipality pursuant to Chapter 1, Title 1 of the Truk District Code, shall create a presumption of residency in that municipality.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its approval by the District Administrator, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
