ACT NO. 27-1-23

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$15,000 from the General Fund of the Truk District Legislature for the purpose of defraying operation costs of the District Division of Agriculture in planting coconut seedlings, seeds and seedlings of various crops and plants on outer islands damaged by Typhoon Pamela, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TRUK DISTRICT LEGISLATURE THAT:

Section 1. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated from the General Fund of the Truk District Legislature for the purpose of defraying operation costs of the District Division of Agriculture in planting coconut seedlings, seeds and seedlings of various crops and plants on outer islands damaged by Typhoon Pamela.

Section 2. The sum appropriated by Section 1 is allotted to the Chief of the Division of Agriculture who shall be responsible to the District Administrator for ensuring that these funds are used only for the purpose specified in Section 1, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. Any part of this appropriation not obligated as of September 30, 1979, shall revert to the General Fund of the Truk District Legislature.

Section 3. The Chief shall submit a report to the Truk District Legislature before May 15, 1979, which shall:

- (1) provide for the full disclosure of the obligations incurred against the sum appropriated by Section 1, and indicate the status of these funds as of April 30, 1979; and
- (2) indicate the planned use, during the final quarter of the fiscal year of funds not obligated as of April 30, 1979.

Section 4. This act shall take effect on October 1, 1978, upon approval by the District Administrator, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
