

AN ACT

Prohibiting use of firecrackers except on certain holidays and other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Truk Legislature that:

Section 1. Enactment. Chapter 6 Title 27 of the Truk District Code is enacted to read as follows:

"Chapter 6. Firecrackers.

125. Firecrackers prohibited

126. Penalty

Section 125. Firecrackers prohibited. It is unlawful for any person to ignite or cause to be exploded or sell any firecrackers, containing gunpowder or an explosive substance capable of making a loud noise, except during the period of seven days prior to New Year's Day or such other holidays as specifically designated by the Governor.

Section 126. Penalty. Any person who violates Section 125 of this Chapter, shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$250.00, by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both."

Section 2. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without approval.
