AN ACT

Enacting Title _____, Chapter _____ of the Truk District Code relating to disturbances of Legislature Business, penalties therefor, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk District:

Section 1. Enactment. Title _____, Chapter _____ is enacted to the Truk District Code to read as follows:

Chapter _____

Section _____ Blockades and notice

Section _____ Unlawful act

Section _____ Penalty

Section _____. Blockades and Notices. The Speaker or Presiding Officer of the Legislature may direct the Sergeant-at-Arms to place blockades and put notices on public roadways and other places which control and prohibit use of motor vehicles and the making of loud noises at times when the Legislature is conducting business

Section _____. Unlawful act. It shall be unlawful for a person to use a motor vehicle or make a loud noise which would disturb the Legislature's business when blockades and notices have been placed nearby the Legislature's building.

Section _____. Penalty. Upon conviction of violation of Section _____ of this Chapter, the punishment shall be by a fine of not more than \$250.00, or by imprisonment for a period not more than 45 days, or by both."

Section 2. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without approval.
