Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk District
Section 1. Enactment. Title, Chapteris enacted to the
Truk District Code to read as follows:

SectionUnlawful act
SectionPenalty
Section <u>Blockades and Notices</u> . The Speaker
or Presiding Officer of the Legislature may direct the
Sergeant-at-Arms to place blockades and put notices on
public roadways and other places which control and pro-
hibit use of motor vehicles and the making of loud noises
at times when the Legislature is conducting business
Section <u>Unlawful act</u> . It shall be unlawful
for a person to use a motor vehicle or make a loud noise
which would disturb the Legislature's business when blo-
ckades and notices have been placed nearby the Legisla-
ture's building.
Section Penalty Upon conviction of viola-
tion of Section of this Chapter, the punishment shall
be by a fine of not more than \$250.00, or by imprisonment
for a period not more than 45 days, or by both."
Section 2. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon
approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without approval.
