## AN ACT

Amending Truk District Law 1-10, opening the flag competition for further entries, increasing the amount of prize money, making other procedural changes and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk District that:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 1 of Truk District Law 1-10 is amended to read as follows:

> "Section 1. Appropriation. The sum of \$500 is appropriated from the General Fund of the Legislature for the purpose of funding prizes for competition to design a flag for Truk."

Section 2. Amendment. Section 5 of Truk District Law 1-10 is amended to read as follows:

> "Section 5. Decision of the Committee. 20 days after the closing of the competition the committee will review all enteries submitted and select three designs which it feels would make a proper flag for Truk. The decision of the Committee shall be upon affirmative vote of at least five members of the Committee."

Section 3. Amendment. Section 6 of Truk District Law 1-10 is amended to read as follows:

> "Section 6. Adoption by the Legislature. After the committee has its selection pursuant to this Act, the Legislature shall adopt one of the three selected designs as the flag of Truk. The designer of the flag adopted by the Legislature shall be awarded the prize of \$500 as the flag of Truk."

Section 4. Amendment. Truk District Law 1-10 is amended by addition of Section 8, to read as follows:

> "Section 8. Extension of time. Notwithstanding the time limitations in section 4, upon unanimous vote of the committee, the time for which entries may be accepted, may be extended. Provided

however, that the final selection of the committee shall not be made later than July 1st 1979."

Section 5. Amendment. Truk District Law 1-10 is amended by addition of Section 9, to read as follows:

> "Section 9. Processing. All entries submitted shall be given to the Speaker or his designee to process the entries by removing names and identifying marks and assigning a number to all entries. After the processing so that the identity of the designer is not made known to the committee, the committee shall then receive the entries and make its decision."

Section 6. Effective Date. This act shall have retroactive effect to December 26, 1978, upon approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without approval.
