AN ACT

Amending Truk District Law No. 21-5, as amended, to prohibit diving to see the "Truk Lagoon District Monument" without the services of a diving guides from any of the duly licensed diving shops in the State, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

Section 1. Amendment. Section 5 of Truk District Law No. 21-5, is amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Permits to Examine.

- seek and obtain access to the aforesaid ships, other vessels and aircraft, or any and all parts thereof, for the purpose of examination shall first obtain a permit therefor from the managers of the duly licensed diving shops in the state, and no person may dive to or by any other means seek and obtain access to the aforsaid ships, other vessels and aircraft, or any and all parts thereof for the purpose of examination without first obtaining a certified diving guide from the duly licensed diving shops in the State. The managers of the duly licensed diving shops are authorized to issue such permits to those persons whom they deem qualified to conduct such examination subject to such rules and regulations as the Governor may prescribe.
- (2) The managers of the duly licensed diving shops in the State shall collect a three dollar (\$3.00) fee for each permit and deliver the collected fees to the State

 Treasurer to be deposited in the General Fund."

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
