AN ACT

To amend Section 7 of Truk State Law No. 21-5, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

Section 1. <u>Amendment</u>. Section 7 of Truk State Law No. 21-5 is amended as follows:

"Section 7. <u>Penalties</u>. Any person who, without the written permission of the Governor, removes, appropriates, damages, or destroys the aforesaid ships, other vessels or aircraft, or any or all parts thereof, or who violates any provisions of this act, any rules and regulations issued pursuant to the act shall, upon conviction, be fined a sum of not more than \$1,000 or be imprisoned for a period of not more than six months, or both."

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
