## AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$45,201 from the General Fund of the Truk Legislature for the purpose of funding the Truk State Recreation Board and its programs, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

Section 1. The sum of \$45,201 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Fund of the Truk Legislature for the purpose of funding the activities of Truk State Recreation Board, as follows:

(a)	Personnel and Benefit \$14,808;
(b)	Travel
(c)	Office Supplies and Equipments 1,093;
(d)	Sporting Goods 2,000;
(e)	Recreation Activities
(£)	State Charter Day
	Lawn Mower (Toro) and Fuel 5,000.

Section 2. The sum appropriated by Section I shall be administered by and is allotted to the Board which shall be responsible to the Governor for ensuring that these funds are used only for the purposes specified in Section 1, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated, provided however, that the sum allocated under item (e) of Section 1 relating to recreational activities may not be expended until such time as the Board is duly organized. Any part of this appropriation not obligated as of September 30, 1981, shall revert to the General Fund of the Truk Legislature.

Section 3. The Board shall submit a report to the Legislature before April 15, 1981, which shall:

- (1) provide for the full disclosure of the obligations incurred against the sum appropriated by Section 1, and indicate the status of these funds as of April 1, 1981;
- (2) indicate the planned use, during the remainder of the Fiscal Year of funds not obligated as of April 1, 1981, provided that a supplemental report covering the actual use and obligation of the fund

shall be submitted to the Legislature or an appropriate committee thereof within 20 days after the closing of the Fiscal Year; and

(3) present the fiscal support requirements of the Recreation Board for Fiscal Year 1982.

Section 4. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
