## AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$10,500, from the General Fund of the Truk Legislature for the purpose of supplementing the funding of municipal projects and for travel expenses for municipal officials of the Hall Islands, and for other purposes.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

Section 1. The sum of \$10,500, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Fund of the Truk Legislature for the purposes of supplementing the funding of municipal projects and travel expenses for municipal officials of the Hall Islands, as set forth below:

- a. Murilo Municipality
  - 1. \$5,000 supplement to PL 1-115;
  - 700 supplement to PL 1-195;
- b. Ruo Municipality
  - 1. \$3,000 supplement to PL 1-95; and
- c. \$1,800 travel expenses for municipal officials.

## Section 2.

- a. The sum appropriated by Section 1 is allotted to the

  Director of the Department of Public Affairs, who shall be responsible to

  the Legislature for ensuring that these funds are used only for the pur
  poses specified in Section 1, and that no obligations are incurred in

  excess of the sum appropriated. Any part of this appropriation not obligated

  as of September 30, 1982, shall revert to the General Fund of the Truk

  Legislature.
  - b. The Director of the Department of Public Affairs shall release funds as are necessary only upon receipt of plans and justifications for the proposed expenditure from the magistrate of the municipality or other authorized person.
- Section 3. The Director of the Department of Public Affairs shall submit a report to the Legislature before April 15, 1982, which shall:
  - a. provide for the full disclosure of the obligations incurred against the sum appropriated by Section 1, and indicate the status of these funds as of April 1, 1982; and
  - b. indicate the planned use during the remainder of the Fiscal Year, of funds not obligated as of April 1, 1982, provided that a supplemental report

covering the actual use and obligation of the fund shall be submitted to the Legislature or an appropriate committee thereof within 20 days after the closing of the Fiscal Year.

Section 4. This Act shall take effect on October 1, 1981, upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
