

AN ACT

To amend Chapter 9, Title 29 of the Truk State Code to increase the alcoholic beverage possession tax, and for other purposes.


Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.


Section 1. Amendment. Section 900 of Chapter 9, Title 29 of the Truk State Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 900. Imposition. A tax on possession of alcoholic beverages within the State of Truk is imposed at the following rates:

- 1) beer and malt beverages:
 - a) in containers of twelve fluid ounces or less, thirty cents per container; or
 - b) in containers of more than twelve fluid ounces, fifteen cents for every four fluid ounces or fraction thereof.
- 2) distilled alcoholic beverages, ten dollars and fifty cents per gallon.
- 3) wine, one dollar and fifty cents per gallon; provided that possession of sacramental wines by religious institutions shall be exempted from this tax."

Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
