AN ACT

Enacting Section 307 of Title 21, Chapter 20 of the Truk District Code relating to the salary of the Sergeant-at-Arms, and for other purposes. Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk District:

Section 1. <u>Enactment</u>. Section 307 of Title 21, Chapter 20 of the Truk District Code is enacted to read as follows:

"Section 307. <u>Salary of Sergeant-at-Arms</u>. The Sergeant-at-Arms of the Truk Legislature shall receive compensation of fifteen dollars per scheduled meeting day of session of the Legislature. In the event that a quorum is not present, the Sergeant-at-Arms shall be entitled to receive compensation for that day."

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
