

AN ACT

Establishing Legal Holidays for the State of Truk, and for other purposes.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

Section 1. Amendment. Chapter 3, Title 1 of the Truk State Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Chapter 3. Holidays

Sections:

50. Holiday

51. Governor's power to proclaim


52. Observance


Section 50. Holiday. The twenty sixth day of September is established as the State Charter Day and shall be observed as a legal holiday each year in Truk State.

Section 51. Governor's power to proclaim. The Governor shall have the power to proclaim and designate other days during the year as legal holidays for the purpose of the public observation or celebrations; provided, however, he shall not proclaim a holiday less than 48 hours in advance of the day to be observed as a holiday. The Governor shall announce all legal holidays with an appropriate proclamation.


Section 52. Observance. When a legal holiday falls on a Saturday, it shall be observed on the preceding Friday. When a legal holiday falls on a Sunday, it shall be observed on the following Monday."

Section 2. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
